FLOODS in JABODETABEK

January 2, 2020



Type : Flood
Location : Jakarta, Bogor, Tangerang, Bekasi
Time : January 2, 2020

I. Key Information

1. Heavy rains since Tuesday flushed the entire Jakarta and surrounding areas until Wednesday morning
2. Jabodetabek is flooded with a height of between 30 cm and 200 cm
3. The distribution of flood points in DKI Jakarta includes North Jakarta 2 points, West Jakarta 7 points, Central Jakarta 2 points, East Jakarta 12 points, and South Jakarta 38 points.
4. Distribution of flood points in the capital buffer zones in Bekasi, Depok and Tangerang, including Tangerang Regency 1 point, Tangerang City 2 points, South Tangerang 5 points, Bekasi City 52 points, and Bekasi Regency 26 points.
5. Number of victims died due to flooding 16 people, DKI Jakarta 8 people, Bekasi City 1 person, Depok City 3 people, Bogor City 1 person, Bogor Regency 1 person, Tangerang City 1 person and South Tangerang 1 person

II. Situation Description

Heavy rain since Tuesday, December 31, 2019 flushed all regions in Jakarta and its surroundings until 07.35 am, the rain continued to flush. As a result, a number of areas in Jakarta and surrounding areas were flooded after being rained overnight. The water level at the Katulampa dam is 170 centimeters, rain conditions and standby status number 2.

A number of areas in Jabodetabek are flooded with varying heights from 30 cm to 200 cm. Based on the results of monitoring, there were 7 sub-districts in South Jakarta and 10 sub-districts in Bekasi City that were flooded.

The distribution of flood areas in DKI Jakarta includes 2 areas in North Jakarta, 7 areas in West Jakarta, 2 areas in Central Jakarta, 12 areas in East Jakarta, and 38 areas in South Jakarta. Severe flooding also occurred in the capital buffer zones in Bekasi, Depok and Tangerang, including Tangerang Regency 1 area, Tangerang City 2 areas, Tangerang Selatan 5 areas, Bekasi City 52 areas, and Bekasi Regency 26 areas.

Heavy rain caused the Cipinang Besar Utara river water overflow into residents' houses in Cipinang Pulomaja settlement, Cipinang Besar Utara, Jatinegara, East Jakarta, RT 06 / RW 11. Nearby areas such as Bekasi on Jl. P. Maluku Perummas 3 East Bekasi Settlement in the area of South Tambun District, Bekasi Regency,

In some areas of Bekasi, West Java, electricity was turned off due to flooding that inundated the area. Power outages occurred around 05.30 WIB.

In addition, causing damage also causing casualties. Until now the data from the National Disaster Management Agency (BNPB) there were 16 people died from flooding with the details of DKI Jakarta 8, Bekasi City 1, Depok City 3, Bogor City 1, Kab. Bogor 1, Kota Tangerang 1, and Tangerang Selatan 1.

II. Urgent Needs

- Evacuation
- Food (ready to eat)
- Mineral water
- Blankets and mats
- Medicines
- Clean water

III. Human Initiative Response

1. Coordinate with the National Disaster Management Agency (BNPB), the Regional Disaster Management Agency (BPBD) and local volunteers
2. Evacuate 66 residents to a safe place, consisting of 11 babies, 19 children, 5 women, 2 boys, 15 elderly and 2 sick people)
3. Rapid Assessments at 4 points, including Pondok Gede, Babelan, Tambun, and Tangerang
4. Open 1 coordination post, 2 mobile posts, and 1 water kitchen post in Pangadegan

IV. Action Plan

1. Evacuation with 2 teams and evacuation equipment
2. Set up water kitchen posts at several points
3. Distribution of ready-to-eat food
4. Distribution of personal hygiene equipment
5. Distribution of cleaning tools
6. Conduct rapid assessment of needs

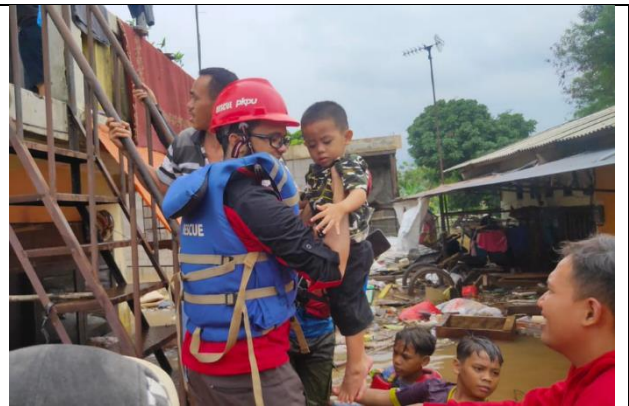
